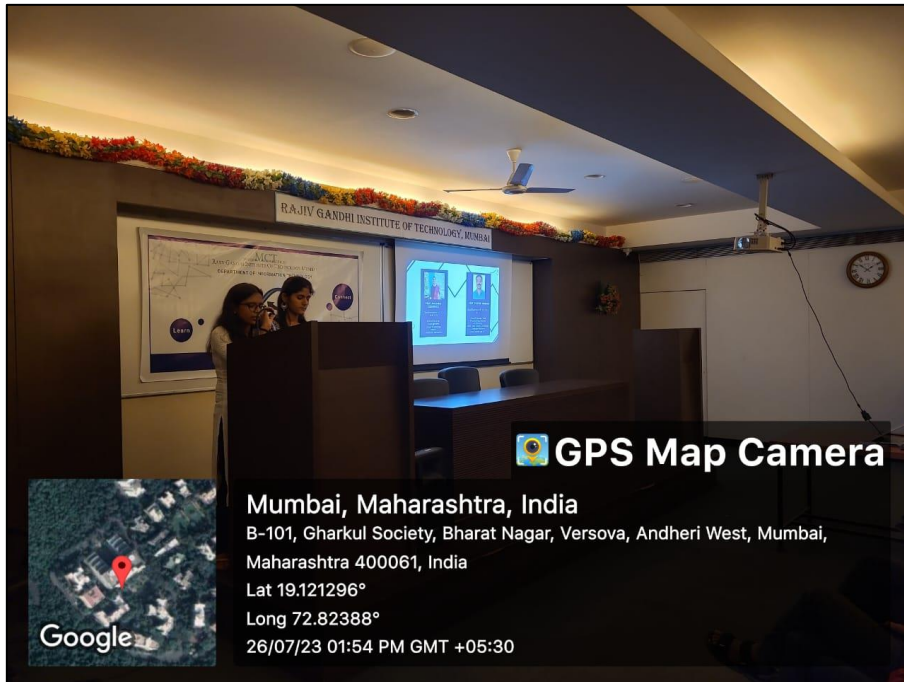

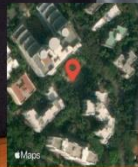
6. On the leetcode Platform, discussion on problem-solving, designing questions for scenarios, and other topics took place.

Further, the workflow of VFX technology was explained i.e. the first step is pre-production which consists of creating visual representation of characters and scenes, second step is the production phase where filming of live action often with green screens in background and motion capturing is done and the last step is where 3D modelling, colouring and compositing is done was explained by the speaker.

Later, the importance of VFX technology in IT sector was emphasized and explained by the speaker to the audience. In conclusion, the event was a great success where the students learnt and got knowledge about VFX technology.

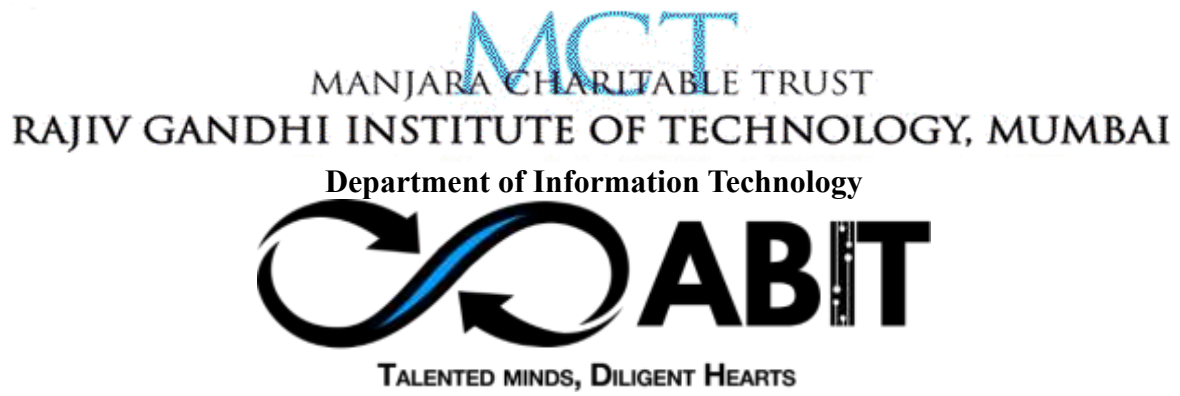
