The purpose of the Language club is to cultivate literary creativity among the students and foster them whose interest lie in uses of different languages for their academic and professional growth.




Establishment of the Club

The LEAD Club has conducted total 5 language activities in the academic year 2021-22. Details of the same are mentioned below.


Activity No. 1


Activity No. 2 TOEFL Orientation






Activity No. 5 <u>German language Course (Complete A1 level)</u>


RGIT's LEAD, in association with ReSolt India, launched a full course, wherein students learnt German (complete A1 level) with live interactive online sessions, doubt solving sessions, mock tests along with notes and study material. From 5th February, 2022 and proceeded further for a total duration of 40+ hours over the weekend. The workshop witnessed the participation of 20 students. The participation fee into the complete coursework was rupees 4,000/- per student and was conducted in hybrid mode. An MoU was signed between the Club and ReSOLT.
